Reflection

In the Gospel today the apostles ask the Lord to increase their faith. Immediately before their request the Lord Jesus has taught them “If your brother does something wrong , reprove him and if he is sorry, forgive him. And if he wrongs you seven times a day and seven times comes back to you and says, “I am sorry”, you must forgive him.” As we know this is a challenging teaching. The apostles recognise this too and therefore they ask the Lord to increase their faith. It is faith that gives us the power to forgive and to seek forgiveness. It is faith that enables us to respond to the challenge of the Gospel and to live lives according to the teaching of Jesus Christ. Without faith we can not see the truth of the Gospel and we are powerless to live it. With faith all things are possible and we can live the Gospel with fidelity and joy. In the week ahead, let us make the apostles prayer our own– Lord, increase our faith.
