EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION AND BENEDICTION & CONFESSIONS

Morning Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction (Monday to Friday) is now 11.30am to 12noon. Eucharist Adoration on Monday and Thursday evening 6pm-7pm will continue as usual as does Saturday morning Adoration.

Having reviewed the times for the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation (Confession), the Sacrament will no longer be regularly available during Thursday evening Adoration. If parishioners cannot make the scheduled times for Confession it is always possible to arrange a mutually convenient time with one of the priests who are always happy to celebrate the Sacrament for you.
